

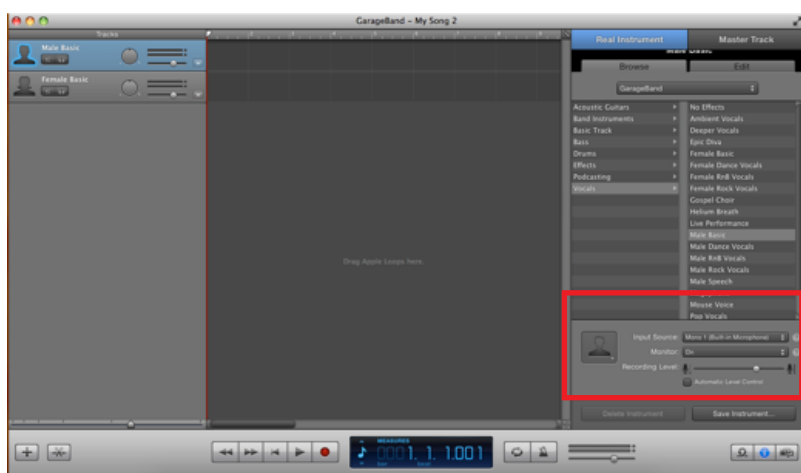
GETTING STARTED WITH GARAGE BAND

CREATING A TRACK



When you open Garage Band, you will be presented with this screen asking what you plan to record. For most users, the answer is **voice**.

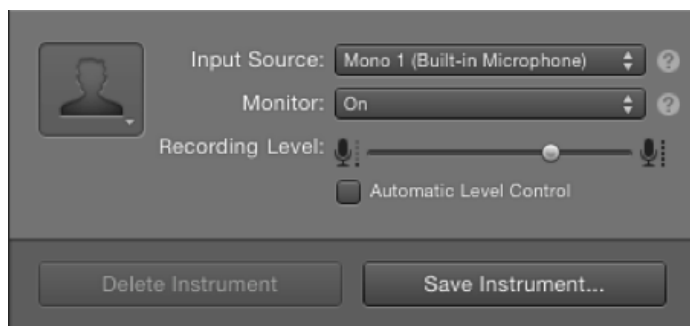
Once you select voice, you are asked to name your session and choose where you would like to save it to in your computer.



When the Garage Band interface opens up, make sure you check to make sure the input source is set to **Mono 1**. Then change the monitor settings to **on**.

NOTE:

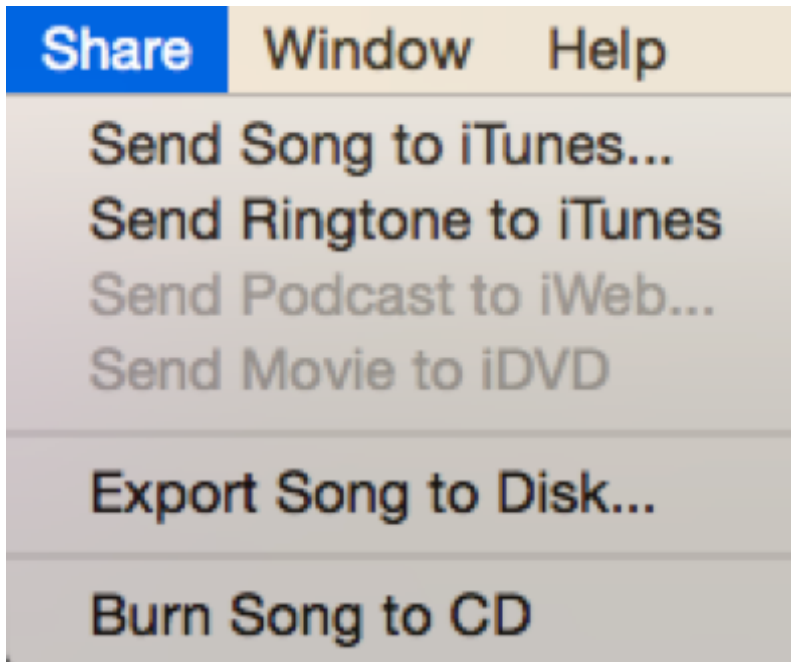
If you can't find the input source, make sure the track information hasn't been toggled off by clicking the center "i" button in the bottom interface.



Then, simply press **record** to begin your recording.

SAVING YOUR FILE



If you'd like you save your file as an mp3, click **Share** from the top menu.

Then select **Export Song to Disk...** from the dropdown menu.

Finally, click **Export**, and as soon as the progress bar finishes, you are done!
